

Sheila's Meditation

The labyrinth is surely not unrelated to a sense of the first path a human being travels ... out of the maternal womb. Every human being's first labyrinth is that of a woman. Jacques Atalli – The Labyrinth in Culture and Society

Womblife lessons, stored in the "many filing places in the storehouse of your heart' (Hugh of St. Victor 1096-1141), remain the subtexts of our life narratives unless we *play-a-tension* to the felt sense of them lying in the "thin skin … membrane of memory … just below the waterline" (Dennis Patrick Slattery, **Just Below the Water Line**, p. 56). In this act of contemplative labyrinth (pr)activism play-a-tension to what shows up on the path of the inner labyrinth that is your body. If you trip on something behind you, get lost, or confused, re-orient to your heart and the subtle alternating waves of potency that move from your center to you edges of your body (and beyond) and back again.

Journal, dance, draw, plant, tell, move, share, store, etc. your experience.

1) LAN members will walk a labyrinth in heart centered coherence with the intention below.

2) Following their walk, LAN members will send messages of support electronically to Dr. McGee through Qualtrics. Photos can be sent via email to her address below.

3) Dr. McGee will download the messages and give them to Father Wismick to share with the counselors.

Intention: Fr. Wismick and the counselors, who are under his supervision in Haiti, will have an immediate and ongoing sense of care and support for the service they are providing to children in orphanages and schools.
