- Heartmath Trauma training: <u>Click Here</u>
 - Redefinition of trauma
 - Secondary trauma: could be indirect exposure, even exposure to media
 - Cummulative exposure
 - Consider your own risk factors
 - Trauma affects brain
 - Modules include the PREP technique, Heart Focused Breathing, Shift and Lift and grounding.
 - Prep Technique is about preparing yourself for your experience, project yourself in the situation being calm and centered. Use this when you decide to help, in transit, anytime



- Shift and Lift asks are you in balanced care or overcare. Be aware of your Torus field of energy
 - Focus on your heart, activate feelings of kindness, radiate heart qualities
- Karen Kelly suggested this book: Your Energetic Boundaries: How to Stay Protected and Connected in Work, Love, and Life, By: Cyndi Dale
